The professorial minimum will be point 68 in band 1 of grade 12.

For academic staff (other than Professors and USLs) contribution will be recognised through the promotions procedure as now and not by use of contribution points. USLs will also have access to the Senior Academic Promotions procedure under which they may also be awarded contribution points 4-5 in grade 10.

Academic-related professorial-equivalent staff will be appointed on the contribution bands of grade 12 according to the HERA points boundaries for each level. Specific arrangements will apply to progression in service-related points on some grades in compliance with the Memorandum of Understanding.
