

**SUBSTITUTE TEACHING SCHEDULE GIVING RATES OF PAYMENT

A. Lecturers	Per Hour	Plus Holiday Pay

These rates are aligned to the first point of Grade 7 (point 39), and incorporate preparation time, set at 4 hours per 1 hour lecture, and 1.5 hours per 1 hour seminar.
